Wind is providing clean, reliable and safe energy to Canadians in every province – creating new social, economic and environmental benefits.

The 198 megawatt Wolfe Island Wind Facility near Kingston, Ontario, includes 86 wind turbines which generate emissions-free energy, provide income for the municipality, local landowners, and create jobs in maintenance and operations.



“I would say the wind development has been a real boost for the whole community. People have to come and see for themselves. When we give tours, people are often surprised at how quiet the wind turbines are. There has been little to no impact on my cow-calf operation and crops.”
