

# Albertans Favour Support for Green Energy

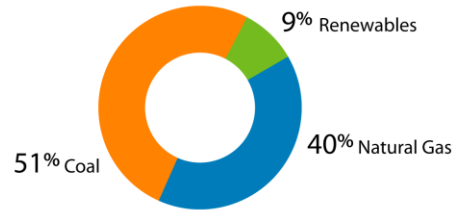

## Albertans Support Renewable Electricity

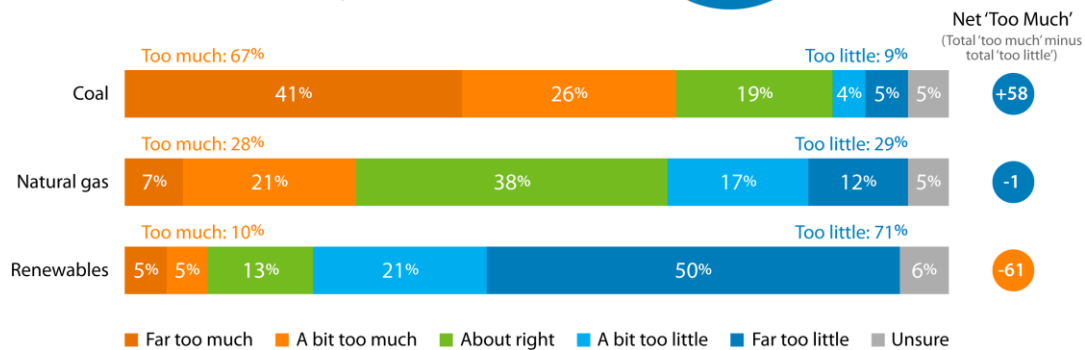
### Views on Alberta’s Current Electricity Generation Mix

The electricity that Albertans use every day is generated from a number of different sources: coal, natural gas and renewables like wind, solar, geothermal, etc. The graph on the right illustrates where Alberta’s electricity comes from today.

“All things considered, do you personally think that too much, too little or about the right amount of electricity is being generated by each of these sources today?”



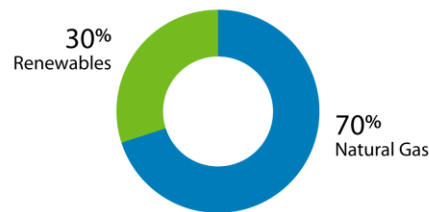

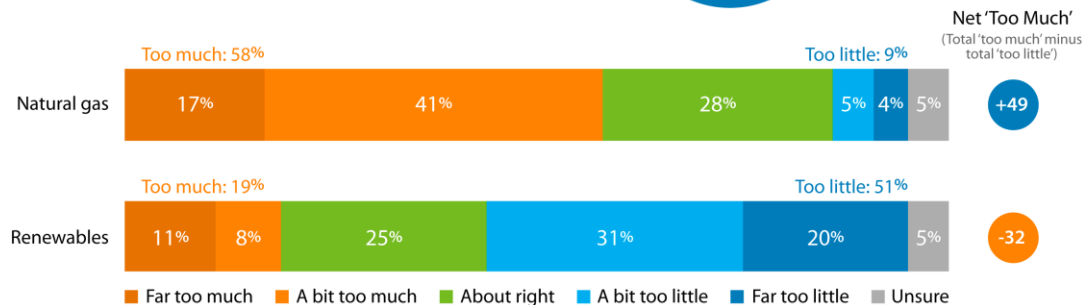
### Views on Alberta’s Projected Electricity Generation Mix

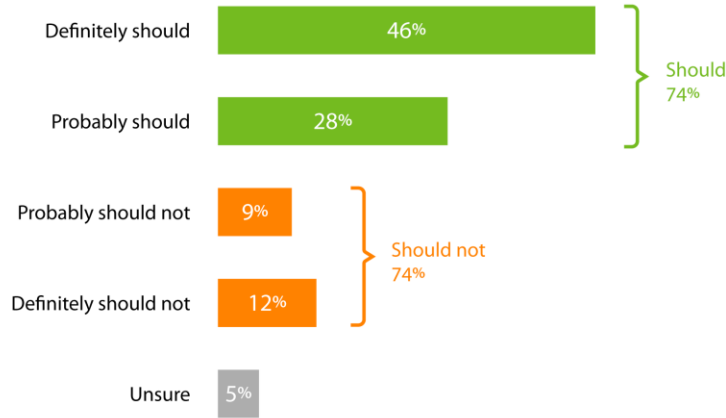

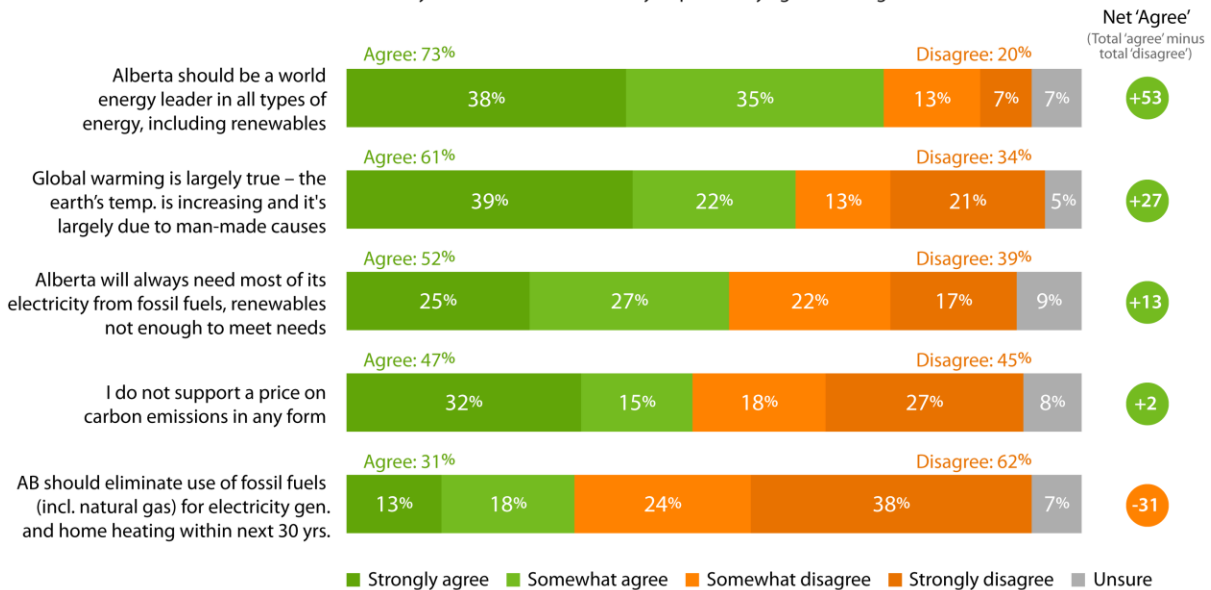
